

The dispensary plays an important role in supporting the health and well-being of the village people. Dispensary at Gorakhpur provides help for those who cannot afford medical treatment, especially for cataract operations. Through regular medical camps, the dispensary identifies patients in need of surgery and offers guidance and support for their treatment. By arranging eye check-up camps and coordinating with Diocese hospital, the dispensary ensures timely and effective care.
